

Dear customers,

on behalf of the Verre Industrie team, we wish you all the best for the year 2019. May it be synonymous with joy and personal fulfilment but also prosperity for your company.

May it be for Verre Industrie the year of controlled development after a year 2018 rich in reorganizations. As you have certainly learned, or even suffered, we have moved part of our production to the adjoining building acquired at the end of 2017, and refurbished the entire historic building.

With an investment plan of €3 million in one year, to which will be added nearly €600,000 in production equipment, we have made an ambitious and unprecedented transformation in the history of Verre Industrie to be able to better meet growing demand.

The production flow is now more logical and fluid, a new glass cutting and storage facility, a machining center and a complementary screen printing machine have been installed. We have hired new staff in production, production organization, quality, and sales administration. You can imagine that there have been many upheavals. At the same time, demand has increased, which has made the task somewhat more difficult.


If you were affected by any delays and difficulties in 2018, we sincerely apologize. We are aware of and sorry for the significant consequences on your company.

Some minor work will still be carried out in the 2nd quarter of 2019. They will only have a very small impact on production. An additional laminating plant arrives in March and a very high-capacity chemical strengthening furnace is planned for next summer.

The chemical hardening equipment will be of a size unique in France, and one of the largest in Europe. It will enable us to be at the forefront of the transformation of thin glass, which finds new applications every day in electronics, aeronautics, medicine, the automotive industry and the military.

To avoid the pitfalls of 2018, we are setting up a new production monitoring organization that will allow us to better inform you about deadlines and prevent possible overruns. The first effects will be felt in the first quarter of this year.

We thank you for your patience, assure you of our dedication to your projects, and invite you to renew your trust in us in 2019.
